## **BSYO Mid-Season String Audition Requirements January 2025**

If the student's school has a string/orchestra program, the student must be enrolled in their school's string/orchestra program to participate in BSYO.

Audition Location: Eau Gallie High School

Audition Day: January 6, 2025

Audition Time Slots: 5:00p.m.- 9:00 p.m.

To audition for BSYO, you must:

1. Register at www.bsyo.us

2. Sign-up for an audition time slot via the Sign-Up Genius on the "Auditions" tab at the above website.

**String Ensemble:** String Ensemble is designed for developing string players and the group plays middle school literature. Students auditioning for String Ensemble should prepare the following:

• 3 major scales and arpeggios: D, G, & C (one octave required, two/three octaves optional)

Solo of the student's choosing that best showcases playing ability (about 1 minute)

• No sight-reading or Excerpts 1, 2, 3 required.

**Festivo Orchestra:** Festivo Orchestra is an intermediate ensemble and the group plays advanced middle school/early high school literature. Students auditioning for Festivo Orchestra should prepare the following:

Excerpt 1 (found on <u>www.bsyo.us</u>)

- o Students will be asked to play a portion of the Excerpt 1, chosen by the directors.
- Major scales and arpeggios from this list (students can play additional octaves if they wish):
  - Violin: Two octaves C, G, D / One octave A, F
  - o Viola & Cello: Two octaves C, G, D / One octave A, F
  - o Bass: One octave C, G, D, A, F
  - o Students will be asked to play one scale from the list, chosen by directors.
- There will also be a short sight-reading excerpt given out at the audition.

**Chamber Orchestra:** Chamber Orchestra is an advanced ensemble and the group plays advanced high school literature. Students auditioning for Chamber Orchestra should prepare the following:

- Excerpt 1 & 2 (found on www.bsyo.us)
  - o Students will be asked to play a portion of Excerpts 1 & 2, chosen by the directors.
- Major scales and arpeggios from this list (students can play additional octaves if they wish):
  - o Violin: Two octaves C, G, D, A, F, Bb, Eb
  - Viola & Cello: Two octaves C, G, D, A, F, Bb, Eb
  - o Bass: Two octaves G, F / One octave C, D, A, Bb, Eb
  - o Students will be asked to play one scale from the list, chosen by directors.
- There will also be a short sight-reading excerpt given out at the audition.

Symphony Orchestra Strings: The Symphony Orchestra is our most advanced ensemble that plays collegiate and professional level repertoire. Students auditioning for the Symphony Strings should prepare the following:

- Excerpt 2 & 3 (found on www.bsvo.us)
  - Students will be asked to play a portion of Excerpt 2 & 3, chosen by the directors.
- Major scales and arpeggios from this list (students can play additional octaves if they wish):
  - Violin: Three octaves G. A. Bb / Two octaves C. D. F. Eb
  - Viola & Cello: Three octaves: C. D. Eb / Two octaves G. A. F. Bb
  - o Bass: Two octaves C, G, A, F, Bb / One octave D, Eb
  - o Students will be asked to play one scale from the list, chosen by directors.
- There will also be a short sight-reading excerpt given out at the audition.
